

Gemma Yeomans Photography – Terms and Conditions

Portrait Photography

(newborns, cake smash, studio and outdoor portraits, maternity, family)

The photography session Terms and Conditions are between Gemma Yeomans Photography and the client names in the contract on booking. Both the photographer and the client agree to abide by the full terms of this contract at all times. No additional agreements shall be considered valid upon signing to this agreement.

1. The photographer cannot extend the time of the session if a client arrives late due to the photographers booking schedule and personal commitments.
2. Client agrees to pay photographer full amount for the photography session and the minimum package price with the included images. Client will have the opportunity to purchase additional digital images after the photography session. Client agrees to purchase additional desired images or wall art at the price agreed in writing by the photographer.
3. Parents will be responsible for the actions of their children at all times. Gemma Yeomans Photography cannot be held liable for accidents that occur as a result of a parent or guardian not watching their child. In the case of newborns and small children, the parent or guardian may be asked to help with “spotting” and need to be in reach of the child at all times to prevent falling or accidents of any kind. The photographer will direct the parent as to where they will need to be to get the safest and best picture. Some props in the studio are very fragile and the paper backdrops can tear so PLEASE do not allow children to play on props or near backdrops unless instructed to do so for photo purposes only.
4. The client shall assist and cooperate with the photographer to obtain the desired photographs. Photographer shall not be held responsible for images not taken, as a client's failure to provide reasonable assistance and cooperation. Client agrees that the photographer cannot guarantee certain poses or a set amount or style of photographs during the session. Additionally, Client agrees not to hold the photographer liable for compromised or poor-quality images due to the lack of cooperation or by the child becoming upset, another 15 min session will be booked for another day free of charge, client will still need to pay the minimum package fee regardless.

5. Gemma Yeomans Photography retains the copyright to all images take, and hereby grants the client permission to unlimited but not exclusive rights to print the images for personal use providing that these are not altered or edited in any way including borders and filters on social media. No images can be given to another company for commercial use, unless written permission is granted by the photographer. In which case the photographer will provide the images with the photographers' logo - not the client.
6. Images shall be provided to the client in digital format, on cd, or any other format seen suitable by the photographer. Images must not be cropped, altered or edited in any way by the client or any other person or professional unless permission in writing is given by the photographer.
7. The photographer may use images for commercial use via print or internet including social media. The photographer must have your consent to do this – so please tick the boxes on the contract provided if you want us to.
8. Finally, anyone that enters the studio including anyone that is not being photographed must be completely free of illness. Sickness – same rules as school apply 48 hours from being sick is the rule for entering the studio. 24 hours notice must be given to the photographer if you are unable to make your appointment for whatever reason. Less than 24 hours and 50% of your deposit is either retained or added on as a cancellation charge.
